The mission of the Field Neurosciences Institute is the prevention, early diagnosis, care and cure of neurological diseases, disorders and injuries.

Research: Supporting clinical and pre-clinical neuroscience research for treating injury and diseases of the brain and spinal cord.

Education: Supporting programs that teach community and health provider education; offering free continuing medical education credits and lab experience for students.

Support Groups: Supporting local spinal cord injury and multiple sclerosis support groups and providing expert speakers and assistance to other support groups, including those for Huntington’s disease, Parkinson’s disease and Alzheimer’s disease.
